Electrofied fence or byo pens

Bring ropes 12 foot and 21 foot

Rope halters

Groundwork crop horsemanship tool 120cm ( professional choice riding stick ) being primary use to be used as extended arm. Preference with a loop on on the end.

orders can be placed prior to clinic

Saddle and bridle that you are currently riding in.

dress warm with layers, warm jackets, gloves and beanies for the winter.

sun block for the warmer days
